#### **SAN FRANCISCO**

Days 6: Travel down into the lowest, driest, and hottest places in North America (C)

#### **ZION NATIONAL PARK**

Days 7-8: Climb 1500 feet (457 m) above the valley floor to Angel's Landing to view the Virgin River that cut through the many colors of sandstone (C)

#### **LAS VEGAS**

Day 9: Enjoy the VIP night and test your luck at the end of our adventure (H)

Day 10: Trip Ends Today


Running Las Vegas to San Fran: Hotel included in Las Vegas both nights but not San Fran

## San Francisco

## Yosemite National Park



Venturing from the city life in San Fran, it's only a short drive to this amazing national park that was carved out by glaciers, rivers and waterfalls. Sheer granite cliffs rise above the valley floor, one of the most notable, Half Dome. Yosemite's most notable rock formation rises 4,737 feet (1,444 m) above the valley floor. Whether you are ready for an all-day hike up Half Dome, a short stroll along the boardwalks in the valley or content gazing at Ansel Adams' photography, this park fulfills all comers.

**Included:** Hiking and National Park Fee

**Optional Activities:** Bike Rental \$12/hr:\$32/day

## Sequoia National Park



No doubt what draws people here are the largest trees in the world, the giant Sequoia. But, the Sequoia National Park has an unprecedented amount of diversity in its scenery, elevations along with the flora and fauna. Also, humans have lived in this area for 6-7,000 years producing over 500 Native American and 100 historic preserved archeological sites.

**Included:** Visit Sequoia National Park, Entrance Fees

## Death Valley National Park



Driving down into the depths of Death Valley, we see the stark contrast between it and Yosemite yet we're in the same state! Death Valley is the lowest, driest, and hottest place in North America. The geologic diversity is unparalleled with salt flats, volcanic debris, multitude of colors, oasis, sand dunes, and peaks reaching over 11,000 feet (3,455 m). Despite the name, this park hosts a great diversity of life.

**Included:** Visit and Entrance National Park, Scenic Drive Death Valley

## Zion National Park



Over 150 million years of rock can be seen throughout this park that is a part of the Grand Staircase (Grand Canyon, Zion, and Bryce). We will camp in the valley next to the Virgin River, enjoy the quaint town of Springdale, and climb up to Angel's Landing to watch the sunrise. The autumn color displays will have started before we get to the park, making this a photographer's paradise.

**Included:** Hike up to Angel's Landing and Scenic Drive Zion NP, Entrance Fees

**Optional Activities:** Horseback Riding 1 Hr (\$45) - 2 Hr (\$75) - 4 Hr (\$135) - Full Day (\$180), Sunset Jeep Tour \$30
